SYNOPSIS

Step into a world where rhythm unravels, gravity dissolves and energy converges. . .

Vortex is the new dance production by Julia Robert & Rudi Cole, where the stage becomes the 'eye of the tornado.' Intuitively composed as a journey from darkness to light, the piece explores the physical and energetic phenomenon of a vortex, and how we, as human beings, can activate deep reserves of unexplored resilience to adapt and transform ourselves in the midst of chaos.

Performed by the international powerhouse HUMANHOOD dancers, the cast moves with precision and virtuosity, synchronising seamlessly with a cinematic soundscape that resonates throughout the auditorium, immersing the audience in the pulse of the dance.

Between extreme physicality and spiritual elevation, *Vortex* takes both dancers and audience to the limits of human endurance, swept away by the hypnotic and overwhelming dynamics of a vortex.

THE STORY

HUMANHOOD's story is a love story, ignited by the meeting of founders Julia Robert and Rudi Cole and their shared love of dance and movement.

Together, through rigorous training and spiritual exploration, they have developed a unique and innovative movement practice and dance methodology that helps dancers connect to the essence of movement.

Their award-winning work fuses physicality and spirituality with a unique body language that is known by its exquisite fluidity and extraordinary rhythmically. Since 2016, they have created six dance productions, performing in over twenty countries at renowned festivals and venues such as the Venice Biennale, Festival Grec (Barcelona), Sadler's Wells (London), PAMS (Seoul), CINARS (Montreal), as well as being commissioned by the BBC for the show dance film *Infinity*.

In 2021, they were selected for Aerowaves21 and became Associate Artists at Mercat de les Flors. Their work has received multiple nominations & prices, including 1st price in Madrid's Choreographic Competition, best choreography at the Catalan Critics Awards for their group piece *TORUS* and at Premis Butaca for ∞ {Infinite}.





Alex Thirkle is a dynamic and expressive dancer whose movement bridges the primal and the poetic. He joined HUMANHOOD in 2021 as a intern during the R&D phase of ∞ {Infinite}, and has since then become a core member of the company. A graduate of the Rambert School of Ballet and Contemporary Dance, his previous credits include working with Russell Maliphant, Sharon Eyal, and Juliano Nunes, as well as appearances in projects with FKA Twigs and Koreless.

AINHOA YUANTAO

"I want to communicate to audiences Humanhood's unique philosophy of movement, connected with the energies around us and the earth, while expressing the power and strength that the body holds."



Ainhoa Yuantao is a Spanish-Chinese dancer whose background spans contemporary, urban, and ballroom dance. In 2024, she joined HUMANHOOD as part of the original cast for Vortex and also took part in the restaging of ∞ [Infinite]. Ainhoa trained at the Ana Laguna Professional School of Dance and has performed in works by Sadeck Waff and Sharon Fridman, among others.

TZU-YI TSENG

"For the performances of Vortex, I would like to say to the audience: Feel us, but feel yourself too."



Originally from Taiwan, Tzi joined HUMANHOOD in 2019 for the creation and tour of the company's first group piece entitled Torus. He was also in the original cast for the productions ∞ {Infinite} and Vortex, where he performed the work at Venice Biennale, Festival Grec Barcelona, CINARS Montreal and Sadler's Wells, among others. Tzi trained at the Taipei National School of the Arts, and has become one of the longest standing dancers of the company.

MAURICIO ZÚÑIGA

"With Vortex, I want the audience to not just watch the show but to let be carried by the energy we create on stage, entering a space that awakens sensations, open inner landscapes."



Mauricio Zuñiga is a Chilean contemporary dancer based in France. In November 2024, he joined HUMANHOOD as original cast of Vortex and restage of ∞ {Infinite}. He trained at Institut del Teatre de Barcelona and joined the Compagnie Junior de Genève, where he performed works by Marcos Morau, Hofesh Shechter, and Sharon Eyal.

SIYU LU

"As we get ready for the premiere of 'Vortex', I hope to bring the audience into the experience, making them feel the powerful flow of energy that the piece embodies."



Siyu Lu is a cross-cultural dancer blending traditional Chinese training with Western contemporary dance. Originally from China, Siyu joined HUMANHOOD in 2024 for the creation of Vortex, as well as the re-staging of ∞ [Infinite]. She trained at Leeds Beckett University and is currently pursuing an MA in Dance Performance at the London Contemporary Dance School.

POL GUIMERÀ

"I hope to convey the light and darkness of movement, a movement that is not judged in the doing. I also hope to communicate how the energy is built with the group and how we move it together as a whole."



Pol Guimerà is a dancer based in Barcelona, who has worked with companies such as Dagoll Dagom and Cia Impuxibles. In 2025, he joined HUMANHOOD for the performances of Vortex.
